In continuation of the advertisement given by the College for the various posts of Assistant Professors vide Hindustan Times dated August 20, 2013 and Employment News dated September 7, 2013, it is hereby notified that, as per the revised roster approved by the University of Delhi vide letter no. CB-II/110/Roster/Advt/MTC/43/519 October 15, 2013, there are some changes in the number and nature of the posts advertised by the College as given below:

UR-Unreserved, OBC-Other Backward Classes, SC-Schedule Caste, ST-Schedule Tribe, PwD-Persons with Disability, OH-Orthopedically Handicapped.

Those who have already applied need not apply again. One post shall be filled-up with Orthopedically Handicapped candidate in the subject/category wherever a suitable candidate is available.

### **Essential Qualifications for the posts of Assistant Professor:**

1. Good academic record with at least 55% (50% for candidates belonging to SC/ST person with Disability viz physically and visually disabled or those who passed their Master's degree prior to 19-09-1991 and hold a Ph.D degree) or an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D, E & F at the Master's degree level in the relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from a foreign University.
2. Candidates must have qualified the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC/CSIR or a similar test accredited by the UGC (state level eligibility test-SLET/SET).

### **FOR POST OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION\***

1. Master's degree in Physical Education/Sports(two years course) or equivalent degree with at least 55 % marks (50% marks for candidates belonging to OBC and those who passed their Master's degree prior to 19-09-1991 and hold a Ph.D. degree or an equivalent grade in the seven point scale with letter grade O, A, B, C ,D, E & F plus a consistently good academic record.
2. Candidates must have qualified the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or any other agency approved by the UGC.
3. Record of having represented the University/College at the Inter-University Competition or the State in National Championships.
4. Passed the Physical fitness test :

However, before taking the test, candidate shall produce a medical certificate, certifying that she is medically fit.

\* It is clarified that those who did their Masters degree as one year D.P.Ed. and one year M.P.Ed. shall also be considered eligible, subject to concurrence of the UGC.

**General Note:-**

1. Candidates who are or have been awarded Ph.D. degree in compliance of the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and procedure for awards of M. Phil / Ph.D. degree), Regulations, 2009 shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET.
2. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Degree Programmer in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET accredited test is not conducted.
3. The candidates applying under PwD category may specifically mention in application their main category to which they belong i.e. UR/SC/ST/OBC for the purpose of computing the reservation.
4. The candidates applying under PwD category are required to submit the Disability Certificate in the format prescribed by Government of India, Department of Personnel and Training vide OM No. 36035/3/2004- Estt (Res) dated 29.12.2005. The format is available at the website [www.permisin.nic.in](http://www.permisin.nic.in).
5. The candidates already in service must apply through proper channel.
6. The College reserves the right to change the number and nature of posts advertised or not to fill up any or all the post(s) advertised.
7. Application form may be obtained from the office of the College from 10.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on or before the last date of submission either in person or by sending a self addressed and stamped envelope of 22cm X 9 cm. **Application form is also available on College website [www.maitreyi.ac.in](http://www.maitreyi.ac.in) and the University website [www.du.ac.in](http://www.du.ac.in).**
8. Separate applications have to be submitted for each post.
9. Applications on the prescribed form must reach the Principal, Maitreyi College New Delhi-110021 on or before **November 22, 2013** complete in all respect with self attested copies of certificates, mark sheets, testimonials etc., alongwith a demand draft of Rs. 250/- (for General/OBC) and Rs. 100/- (for SC/ST/ Pwd) in favor of the Principal, Maitreyi College.
10. Merely fulfilling the minimum eligibility conditions does not entitle the candidates to be called for interview. The application received shall be screened in accordance with the guidelines laid down by the University in this regard, to restrict the no. of candidates.
