Vacancies for Assistant Teachers

Here is an opportunity to be a part of this noble profession. Jharkhand Academic Council invites applications for the post of Assistant Teacher. The appointment will be made in the Secondary Schools of the State. The details regarding the vacancies are mentioned below:

1. Assistant Teachers

Number of Vacancies: 2513

QUALIFICATION: The minimum educational qualification for all the subjects except Sanskrit, Urdu, Farsi, Arabic and Music are as follows:

- (i) The candidate should possess a Bachelor's Degree in Arts, Science or Commerce in the concerned subjects with an aggregate of a minimum of 45% marks (40% for SC/ST) from a recognized University/Institution.
- (ii) The candidate should possess a B.Ed Degree recognized by National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) or State Government.

The Minimum educational qualification for the subjects viz. Sanskrit, Urdu, Farsi, and Arabic are as follows:

- (i) The candidate should have an Acharya degree (Literature and Grammar) or Faazil degree (Arabic, Urdu or Faarsi) from a recognized University/Institution or a Bachelor's degree in Arts with Sanskrit/Arabic/Urdu/Farsi with at least 45% marks (40% for SC/ST) from a recognized University/Institution.
- (ii) The candidate should possess a B.Ed Degree recognized by National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) or State Government.

The minimum educational qualification for Music is as follows:

- (i) The candidate should have passed Matriculation from a

recognized board.

(ii) The candidate should have a Bachelor's degree in Music from a recognized University/Institution.

AGE LIMIT: Minimum 21 years as on 01.01.2011

Maximum age limit as per the category is as follows:

- (i) General: 40 years
- (ii) Female (UR/BC/EBC): 43 years
- (iii) Extreme Backward Classes/BC: 42 years
- (iv) SC (Male/Female): 45 years
- (v) ST (Male/Female): 45 years

EXAMINATION FEE: (i) The candidates have to deposit examination fee of Rs 750/- . (ii) The candidates belonging to SC/ST category have to deposit fee of Rs 375/- (iii) The candidates have to deposit the fee through Demand Draft issued by a Nationalized Bank drawn in favour of **Jharkhand Academic Council Fund and payable at Ranchi**.

(iv) Candidates should mention their name and address on the back of the Demand Draft.

(iii) Last date for depositing the application form is 25th November, 2011.

(iv) The applications sent by any other means except Speed Post will not be accepted.

(v) The candidate can submit only one application against the relevant subject. The subject mentioned by the candidate in the application form will be taken as final. Candidates can not apply against any other subject.

(vi) The applications should reach on or before the last date, i.e. 25th November, 2011. Applications received after the last date will be summarily rejected.

(vii) All the candidates should keep a Xerox Copy of the Application form and the Demand Draft against the Examination fee.

(viii) The envelope should be superscribed with "**Advertisement Number and the name of the subject applied for**" otherwise the application will be rejected.

(ix) The applicants are required to mention the subject code in the application form.

(x) The candidates have to fill in the relevant category code in the application form.

(xi) Candidates have to mention the centre code of the examination centre of their choice.

(xii) The candidates are required to attach following self-attested documents along with the application form:

- Certificate for the relevant qualification (Matriculation, 10 +2 Certificate and Graduation Marksheets & Certificate)
- Post qualification certificate (i) B.Ed certificate (ii) Certificate against Teacher's Training (ii) Certificate for appearing the training examination.
- Age Proof
- Caste certificate issued by the Competent Authority
