The above vacancies are now in existence. The list of selected candidates published by the Commission in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancies noted above and the vacancies that may be reported to the commission in writing during the currency of the list.

Note: - 3% vacancies shall be reserved for physically handicapped candidates for recruitment to the post eligible as per G.O (P) No: 11/2009/SWD.dt 10.2.09.

- 6. Age Limit 19-43, only candidates born between 02.01.1967 and 01.01.1991 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for the post; Other : Backward Communities and SC/ST candidates are eligible for usual age relaxation. (For conditions regarding the age relaxation please see Para (2) of the General Conditions)

7. Qualifications: -

- 1. Pass in S.S.L.C or its equivalent qualification
AND
- 2 (a) National Trade Certificate in the particular trade with three-year experience in the trade after obtaining the certificate.
OR
- (b) National Apprenticeship Certificate in the trade with one -year experience in the trade after obtaining the certificate.
OR

(c) Diploma in the appropriate branch of Engineering from a Government or Government recognized polytechnic or its equivalent qualification.

Note: - (i) The experience gained by a Workshop Attender on the trade can also be deemed to be qualifying experience in the trade for selection to this post.
(ii) Candidates belonging to SC/ST will be exempted from the qualification of experience prescribed in 2(a) and (b) above.
