NCA NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited on-line only from qualified candidates belonging to reservation group of communities of Kerala State Viz.Muslim for appointment in the under mentioned post.

1. Name of the firm : State Farming Corporation of Kerala Limited
2. Name of Post : Driver Grade II/Tractor Driver
3. Scale of Pay : ₹ 3050-5230
4. No. of Vacancies : Muslim 1 (One)

Note (i) The above vacancy is now in existence. The ranked list published as per this notification will be valid until candidates are advised and appointed against vacancies earmarked for the community mentioned above but unfilled due to the paucity of candidates during the currency of the ranked lists published on 23.7.2007 for the post.

(ii) The Kerala public Service Commission shall have the power to cancel the advice for appointment of any candidate to the service of State Farming Corporation of Kerala Limited if it is subsequently found that such advice was made under some mistake. On such cancellation the appointing authority shall terminate the service of that candidate provided that, the cancellation of advice for appointment by the Commission and subsequent termination of service of the candidate by the appointing authority shall be made within the period of his/her probation or 240 days from the date of his/her joining duty whichever is earlier.

5. Method of appointment – Direct Recruitment (from Muslim community only)

Note: The applications submitted by candidates belonging to other than Muslim communities will be rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to them individually.

6. Age : 18-38, Only candidates born between 2.1.1972 and 1.1.1992 are eligible to apply for the post (both dates included). (Including relaxation in Para 2(i) of the General conditions)

Note:

The provisional hands working in the above concern will be given age relaxation to the extent of their provisional service put in subject to a maximum of five years from the upper age limit provided they are within the prescribed age limit on the date of their first appointment in the above concern. But the regular employees of the concern are not eligible for the above concession for further appointment. The provisional hands should obtain a certificate showing the period of their provisional service in the concern and shall produce the same as and when required by the Commission. It would also be clearly specified in the certificate that they were not working in the regular service of the concern. (For other conditions regarding the age relaxation see para 2(ii),(iii),(iv),(vi)&(xii) of the General Conditions)

7. Qualifications :-

1. Pass in Standard VII (new) or its equivalent qualification.
2. Current driving licence with endorsement to drive heavy motor vehicle and tractor. Heavy duty driving licence issued after 16-1-1979 must have endorsement both for heavy goods and heavy passenger vehicles and the applications of candidates possessing licence with only one endorsement will be summarily rejected.

3. One year's experience in driving heavy motor vehicles in a Government/Quasi Government Institution or a Registered Firm.

4. Medical Fitness as per Motor Vehicles Act and Rules.

Note:- (1) The medical certificate (in original) issued in the prescribed form by a Medical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon regarding the Physical fitness and a Medical Certificate regarding vision from an ophthalmologist in Government Service in the prescribed format must be produced as and when asked for by the Commission. The prescribed forms of Medical Certificates are given below.

(2) Physically handicapped persons are not eligible to apply for this post.

(3) Candidates should possess current driving licence on the last date for receipt of application in this office and also on the date of Practical test/ Interview.

(4) The proficiency in driving will be assessed by conducting a Practical test by the Commission.

8. Mode of submitting Applications:

The applications shall be submitted by On-line only . Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission viz. www.keralapsc.org. No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualification, age, experience and community have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are not submitted in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.


