Applications are invited online only from qualified Physically Handicapped candidates belonging to blind (Partially blind) category in the state of Kerala against the vacancies reserved for them for the following post.

1. Department	:	Economics & Statistics
2. Name of Post	:	Lower Division Compiler/ Investigator
3. Scale of pay	:	Rs.4990-7990/-
4. No.of vacancies	:	District wise Wayanad Physically Handicapped (Blind) 1- (One) (Partially blind candidates alone are eligible)

Note:-

- 1) Conventional type applications for the above post will be summarily rejected. Candidates shall apply only through online application available at the Kerala Public Service Commission website.
- 2) A Ranked list will be prepared for Wayanad District in pursuance of this notification. Ranked list thus prepared and published by the Commission shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the Physically Handicapped persons-(Blind) turns identified as unfilled during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following district.

- 3) The selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on a Revenue District basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in GO(MS) No.154/71/PD dated, 27.5.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue district from the ranked list prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes 5 years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after 5 years, it will be subject to the rules in GO(MS) No. 4/61/PD dated, 2.1.1961.Candidates already in Government Service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply for higher posts when notified.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment from among Physically Handicapped – Blind (Partially Blind candidates only)

Note: Application submitted by candidates other than those belonging to Physically Handicapped Blind (Partially Blind) will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to them individually.

6. Age Limit : 19-35. Only Candidates born between 2.1.1975 and 1.1.1991 are eligible to apply for this post. (Both dates included) with usual relaxation to Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe, Other Backward Communities.

Note:- For details regarding other age relaxations, subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 (Fifty) years, please see para(2) of the General Conditions under Part II of this Notification.

7. Qualifications:

1. A pass in SSLC or equivalent examinations with not less than 60% marks in Mathematics
Or
A Computer certificate ABC of the Indian Statistical Institute, Calcutta
Or
A National Diploma in Commerce

Note:- 1) 60% marks in Mathematics in SSLC will not be insisted upon in the case of Last Grade Servants employed in the Economics & Statistics Department and in the case of Graduates in Mathematics, Economics, Statistics or Commerce.

- 2) Candidates should note the percentage of marks secured for Mathematics in the SSLC Examination. Candidates who do not possess 60% marks in Mathematics for SSLC and who possess degree in Economics, Mathematics, Statistics, Commerce must note in the application col.6(a) the subject of the degree possessed in brackets.

9. Candidates are allowed to submit the application by Online only.

Applications should be submitted by Online facility provided in the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. The barcode number in the application form shall be quoted in all further enquiries/ correspondence. Documents to prove qualifications, age, community etc have to be produced as and when called for.
