- Attach only Xerox copies (not originals) of marks/grades obtained in B.Sc and M.Sc.(first year) or B.Tech (first three years)
- In case the mark sheet/grades for the 2nd semester (first year) of M.Sc. or 6th semester (last semester of prefinal year) in case of B.Tech. students are not available, the candidate MUST submit a certificate from the college/institute that he/she has appeared for the exams and the results are awaited.
- Do not attach original degree certificates.
- **Statement of purpose, recommendation and the marks are taken into consideration while selection of candidates in addition to the other criteria of the Centre.**
- Recommendation from the Head of the Department or faculty on the prescribed Performa is MUST.
- The decision of the Centre in regard to the selection of candidates shall be final.
- Canvassing in any form and /or bringing in any influence, political or otherwise, will be treated as a disqualification.
- **All candidates selected for the programme would need to spend a minimum period of 60 days in CCMB without any break. This is one of the most important requirement and accordingly, all candidates need to furnish a certificate from the Head of the Department/Competent authority of the college/institute certifying the following:**

- ✓ *that the candidate (candidate's name, the course the candidate is attending) if selected for the Summer programme of CCMB would be allowed to work/stay in CCMB atleast for SIXTY-days without any break, irrespective of the start of their next semester and/or exams etc. (Accordingly, the letter should include the tentative dates during which the candidate would be available for summer training in CCMB);*
- ✓ *that any data generated as part of the summer training/ project work would be solely the copyright of CCMB/CCMB guide.*


