Note: (A) Candidates belonging to reserved categories for which no vacancy has been announced are free to apply against vacancies announced for Unreserved/General category provided they fulfill qualifications, age and other such norms of General category as stipulated. (B) Application received for post not advertised in a particular State/UT will not be entertained. (C) This is an All India Test and the recruitment would be on State/UT basis. Candidates can apply for vacancies in one State/UT only and have to appear for the examination, from a centre of that particular State/UT. As the reservation for VH/HI/OH and Ex-servicemen candidates are on horizontal basis, the selected candidates will be placed in the appropriate category to which the candidate belongs.

1. ELIGIBILITY**(A) NATIONALITY/CITIZENSHIP**

A candidate must be either i) a citizen of India or ii) a subject of Nepal or iii) a subject of Bhutan or iv) a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before 1st January 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India or v) a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India. Provided that a candidate belonging to categories (ii), (iii), (iv) (v) above shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government of India. A candidate in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to the examination/interview conducted by the Bank but on final selection the offer of appointment may be given only after the necessary eligibility certificates have been issued to him by the Government of India.

(B) EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION (As on the Date of Application): Graduate in any discipline with 40% or more marks in aggregate from a recognized university or its equivalent qualification. SC/ST/XS/VH/HI/OH candidates must obtain 35% marks. Computer Literacy is essential for the post.

(C) RELAXATION FOR SC/ST/XS/VH/HI/OH CANDIDATES: As per Govt. guidelines in the matter.

NOTE: a. All educational qualifications should be from a Recognised University/Board/Central/State administration. b. Knowledge of the Official Language of the State/UT (to read, write and speak) is essential.

(D) DEFINITION OF EX-SERVICEMEN (XS):

a. Only those candidates shall be treated as Ex-servicemen who fulfil the revised definition as laid down in Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms Notification No. 36034/5/85/Estt (SCT) dated 27th October 1986 as amended from time to time.

b. Disabled ex-servicemen (DISXS): Ex-servicemen who while serving in Armed Forces of the Union were disabled in operation against the enemy or in disturbed areas shall be treated as DISXS.

c. Dependents of Servicemen killed in Action (DXS): Servicemen killed in the following operations would be deemed to have been killed in action attributable to Military Service (a) war, (b) war-like operations or border skirmishes either with Pakistan on cease fire line or any other country, (c) Fighting against armed hostiles in a counter insurgency environment viz., Nagaland, Mizoram, etc. (d) Fighting of service with peace-keeping mission abroad, (e) Laying or clearance of mines including enemy mines as also mine sweeping operation between one month before and three months after conclusion of an

operation, (f) Frost-bite during actual operations or during the period specified by the Govt., (g) Dealing with agitating Para Military forces personnel, (h) IPKF personnel killed during the operations in Sri Lanka.

NOTE: 1. Candidates still serving in Defence and desirous of applying under Ex-servicemen category should submit a certificate from the competent authority to the effect that they would be released/retired on or before 31.12.2010.

2. Ex-servicemen candidates who have already secured employment under the Central Govt. in Group C & D will be permitted the benefit of age relaxation as prescribed for Ex-servicemen for securing another employment in a higher grade or cadre in Group C/D under the Central Govt. However, such candidates will not be eligible for the benefit of reservation for Ex-servicemen in Central Govt. jobs.

(E) RESERVATIONS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES: Reservation is available to Persons with Disabilities under Section 33 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act 1995. Accordingly, candidates with the following disabilities are eligible to apply.

Definition:

• **Visually Handicapped (VH):**

1. Blindness refers to a condition where a person suffers from either of the following conditions:

(i) Total absence of sight.
(ii) Visual acuity not exceeding 6/60 or 20/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with correcting lenses.

(iii) Limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of 20 degrees or worse.

2. Low vision: "Person with low vision" means a person with impairment of visual functioning even after treatment or standard refractive correction but who uses or is potentially capable of using vision for the planning or execution of a task with appropriate assistive device.

• **Hearing Impairment (HI):** "Hearing Impairment" means loss of sixty decibels or more in the better ear in the conversational range of frequencies.

• **Locomotor Disability or Cerebral Palsy (OH):**

1. **Locomotor Disability:** "Locomotor Disability" means disability of the bones, joints or muscles leading to substantial restriction of the movement of the limbs or any form of cerebral palsy.

2. **Cerebral Palsy:** "Cerebral Palsy" means a group of non-progressive conditions of a person characterised by abnormal motor control posture resulting from brain insult or injuries occurring in the pre-natal, peri-natal or infant period of development.

All the cases of Orthopaedically Handicapped persons would be covered under the category of "Locomotor disability or cerebral palsy".

Only such persons would be eligible for reservation in

services/posts who suffer from not less than 40 per cent of relevant disability.

2. **AGE:** Not below 18 years and not above 28 years as on 01.06.2010.

Note: *In addition to the usual period of service in the defense forces. **Certificate to this effect from the competent authority should be produced at the time of interview, if selected for the same.

In case of a candidate who is eligible for relaxation under more than one of the above categories, the age relaxation will be available on cumulative basis with any one of the remaining categories for which age relaxation is permitted as mentioned above. This cumulative age relaxation is available to SC/ST/OBC candidates only.

The Bank reserves the right to add/cancel any centre at its discretion and also to call the candidates for examination at any other centres. The centre will be decided on the basis of State/UT applied as indicated by the candidate. If the State/UT is not indicated, the application will be rejected.
